The Brown Family Children Foundation, Inc. (BFCF) has created an enrichment initiative for children, known as the James Brown Academy of Music Pupils (JAMP). JAMP is an educational melodic year round hub, dedicated to the late Godfather of Soul, James Brown! James Brown, Mr. Dynamite, the hardest working man in show business was a devoted advocate of children, family, and education. Pupils, a.k.a. J'ampers, will spend quality time with worldwide professional musicians and JAMP's staff experimenting, exploring, and incorporating the various spectrums of genres to enhance and develop outstanding young maestros just like the Godfather of Soul!

JAMP is a non-profit village which operates solely on small grants, tuition, and donations. JAMP intentions are to motivate and inspire children through the universal language of music, located in Augusta, Georgia: the stomping grounds of James Brown. James Brown Academy of Musik Pupils will give the children a collection of experiences that will enrich their hidden musical abilities.

The euphony (musical quality) agenda at JB Academy of Musik Pupils is simply extraordinaire! Once J'ampers enroll in JAMP, the exploration of musical theory soars to new heights in every aspect. JAMP sessions will contribute thematic weeks incorporating core subjects of educational sphere, i.e. – Mathematics (measuring rhythms and beats), Geography (studying various genres of music throughout the world), Kinetic Energy (movement and rhythms of dance), and Foreign Languages (deciphering songs in various dialects, i.e. – opera).

Various studies throughout the years have revealed that relationships with music prove advantageous with the social, physical, and emotional development concerning the growth of children.

It is also our belief that education is essential. The God given talent of learning cannot be restricted in performance, but can be combined with the dynamics of the complete child who is capable of learning while changing and capable of changing while being taught. James Brown, was known to “use his brains instead of brawn as a path to gain power”. The Godfather could conduct and play every instrument in his band without formal training. Henceforth, the conception of this project focuses on individual ability, cultural orientation, and linguistics.

To ensure the JAMP handbook has been fully explained and understood, the Administrator or Educational Consultant of JAMP will review the rules and regulations with the parent and the J'amber.

DILATORY ARRIVALS AND DEFICIENT ATTENDANCE

Attendance is a key factor once J'ampers has been accepted in JAMP! Instructors will record attendance at the start of every class. J'ampers are allowed to miss 3 unexcused absences before being dismissed from JAMP's roster*^{check footnote}.

JAMP encourages all appointments to be scheduled before or after JAMP hours. If unforeseen situations arise, that will cause the J'ampers to be tardy or absent, please call the JAMP office that morning so maestros are notified.

J'ampers who arrive laggard should report to the JAMP office with parent to sign in before reporting to class. If J'ampers are laggard 5 times, the Administrator will ask J'ampers to be removed from the JAMP Roll*^{check footnote}.

LUNCH

J'ampers are to bring a packed snack daily to eat in the assigned supervised areas of JAMP. J'ampers are not allowed to leave JAMP while JAMP is in session.

PARKING

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships are awarded if funding permits. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of musical ability and leadership displayed in class and endorsed by JAMP maestro.

MEDICAL

To ensure a healthy and safe environment, all J'ampers must have a current physical from their local pediatrician along with pediatrician's recommendation to attend JAMP.

All health records and medical consent forms must be completed and on file upon enrollment.

The JAMP staff must be AWARE of any medical conditions and medications.

- Medications must be administered by certified JAMP staff after parent has signed medication consent form.

Children are never to have any form of medication in their possession.

FIRST AID

J'ampers should report all incidents (major and minor) to JAMP staff.

J'ampers who become ill, will remain in the office until notified parent or guardian arrives to pick up sick child.

Out of Town Policy

The following procedures will be followed when students travel out of town or on overnight trips.

1. Plan for Appropriate Supervision

a. Teacher/ student ratios must be age appropriate and appropriate for the conditions of the trip. The administrator will review and approve the plan for the supervision of students.

b. Parents will be notified of the staff/ student ratio before the trip. If other adults will travel with the group, that also must be stated. While parents may assist in the supervision of students where needed, if appropriate, parents are not to be made solely responsible of students on the trip.

c. Adults are not to consume alcoholic beverages when supervising students on out-of-town or overnight field trips so as not to risk having impaired judgment should

they need to make a decision on a student's behalf. For purposes of this Regulation, adults are considered to be supervising students at all times during out-of-town or overnight field trips.

d. Parents must be informed, as part of the itinerary, if students will be unsupervised at any time. Expectations for this unsupervised time will be discussed with parents and students in orientation meetings and in written communications.

2. Code of Conduct

Students are expected to follow all J.A.M.P. Bylaws. In addition I understand that if a student: uses alcohol, other drugs or any illegal substance, leaves the group / designated areas without permission of retreat coordinator, breaks curfew or goes into restricted areas (such as being in the bedroom of a member of the opposite sex.), significantly impedes the success of the experience for self or others or becomes a concern to the safety of self or others that the parents be contacted to have their child sent home.

If, for disciplinary reasons, it is necessary to send a student home, the parent will be responsible for making all arrangements to ensure the student's safe return home. A teacher/sponsor will not leave the group to escort a student home. The requirement that the parents make arrangements for the student's safe return home may cause the parent come to the student's location and return home with him/her. A substantial cost can occur to the parents should there be a need to send their child(ren) home early.

Teachers, sponsors and chaperones who are sponsoring an out-of-town or overnight field trip will file a signed copy of the Sponsors Code of Conduct with the principal prior to departure on the trip.

3. Communication

a. For trips involving overnight stays, a parent contact will be assigned to deal with communication needs. This will be noted on the itinerary and website.

b. The sponsor will carry contact numbers for school administration or designee. The school administration will be contacted if any unusual circumstances arise during the trip. Contact must be made for illness, injury, or for major disciplinary issues. If the teacher/sponsor is in doubt, the administrator will be contacted. Staff member chaperones will make arrangements to carry a cell phone at all times.

4. While Traveling

a. The sponsor will carry copies of the Out of Town/ Overnight Permission Slip and Parent Contact at all times.

b. The teacher/sponsor will carry basic emergency first aid supplies.

5. Insurance

Each student MUST be covered by medical insurance.

6. Student Orientation Meetings

Orientation meetings that prepare the students and parents for what the trip entails will be held prior to departure. These meetings are mandatory for participation in the trip.
